NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING: Pursuant to KRS 132.027, the City of Newport, KY will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, September 9 at 4:00 p.m., local time, in the Multi-Purpose Room of the Newport City Building, 998 Monmouth Street, to hear comments from the public regarding a proposed real estate tax rate of \$2.91 per \$1,000 valuation and proposed personal property tax rate of \$2.57 per \$1,000. As required by law, this includes the following information:
