COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE NO. 0-2017-001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT, KENTUCKY AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES §32.064 COMPOSITION OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF NEWPORT, KENTUCKY:

That the Section 32.064 of the Code of Ordinances shall be and is hereby amended to read, as follows:

SECTION I

§ 32.064 COMPOSITION.

PASSED:

The Commission shall consist of 7 members who shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners, all of whom shall be residents of the City and who shall have demonstrated an interest in historic preservation. [At least 1 member shall be a resident of the Mansion Hill Neighborhood, at least 1 member shall be a resident of the Gateway Neighborhood | At least two (2) members shall be residents of the East Row Historic District; at least one (1) member shall be a resident of the York Street Local Historic District; and at least 2 members shall meet the qualifications of a preservation-related professional. Any subsequent local districts that may be created shall also be required to have a representative member thereof. No more than 2 members shall reside outside of the local designated historic districts.

SECTION III

That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested to by the City Clerk, recorded, published and effective upon publication.
